EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County 911 Communications Center is the records custodian for all Rock County public safety audio recordings. The recent conversion of the Public Safety Radio System to a conventional digital system in 2012, it is necessary to upgrade our current analog recording system to digital. This upgrade will enhance the audio recordings from the new radio system making the audio more crisp and clear, as well as offer new features that are not possible on an analog system (i.e; recording of unit ID numbers on radio transmissions). Currently the recording system is connected to control stations at the Sheriff's Department, so we are unable to verify the signals that the dispatch consoles transmit/receive because the system is unable to do so until we complete the upgrade.

Upgrading to a digital recorder will also allow for more functionality (ie; recording caller ID, 911 data feeds, etc.) for telephone recordings when we update our 911 telephone system in late 2013.

General Communications was the original vendor for the analog Eventide recorder and currently holds the maintenance contract for the recording system equipment as well as the interface between the recorder and the dispatch radio consoles.

This item was approved in the Communications Center's 2013 budget and pricing for the quote (\$40,068.75) is based on GSA Contract #GS-35F-0415V.
