WHEREAS, Drug Courts are now recognized as the most successful criminal justice intervention in our nation's history; and,

6 **WHEREAS,** Drug Courts save up to \$27 for every \$1 invested and produce up to \$13,000 for every 7 individual they serve; and,

9 WHEREAS, 75% of Drug Court graduates will never see another pair of handcuffs; and,

WHEREAS, Drug Courts significantly improve substance-abuse treatment outcomes, substantially reduce drug abuse and crime, and do so at less expense than any other justice strategy; and,

WHEREAS, Drug Courts facilitate community-wide partnerships, bringing together public safety and public health professionals in the fight against drug abuse and criminality; and,

17 WHEREAS, there are now 2,966 Drug Courts nationwide; and,

19 WHEREAS, Drug Courts are the cornerstone of criminal justice reform sweeping the nation; and 20

WHEREAS, Rock County started its OWI Court in October 2012, and has had 40 total participants and 10 successful graduates as of May 1, 2015.
