Executive Summary

Amending the 2020 Human Services Department Budget to Accept Additional ADRC Funding

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) has provided \$40,874 in additional funding to the Rock County Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) in 2020.

The ADRC received two awards of funding that was carried over from 2019. The first award in the amount of \$17,087 will be used to offset the 2020 cost of living increase for ADRC personnel. The second award in the amount of \$6,700 was carried over from the Dementia Care Specialist program. These funds will be used to purchase multiple in-home activities such as Garden Stones, craft projects and activity bags for those impacted by dementia and their caregivers. In addition, this funding will be used towards speakers for the monthly memory café programs, participation in the "Grandpa and Lucy" virtual programs, and for educational materials.

The ADRC also received a new \$17,087 federal award to support the ADRC's response to the COVID-19 pandemic. These funds will be used to advertise and purchase Alexa Echoes and Shows for individuals served by the ADRC who may have dementia or memory loss, who may be socially isolated or who could use additional health and safety checks in the home. This funding will also be used to purchase portable stools and headsets for staff conducting client visits or working remotely.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AUTHORIZING EASEMENT TO ALLIANT ENERGY TO CROSS INDIANFORD PARK

The Rock County Parks Department received a request from Alliant Energy to obtain a permanent easement for the installation of a Fiber Optic Communications Line. The proposed easement is in the southern half of a Rock County owned parcel, where the Indianford Park is located. The Park has been under Park possession since 1962.

This Communication Lines purpose is to provide internal communications within Alliant Energy. The line is to be bored throughout the Indianford Park as a means to cross the Rock River and minimize potential future disturbance of the line. Alliant Energy is proposing the installation of the Communication Line in the Southern half of the Park to avoid any conflicts with existing utilities currently buried at that location.

The proposed Communication Line should not interfere with current or future operations of the 1.2 acre site.

Alliant Energy is agreeable to compensating Rock County \$500.00 for the easement. This value is based on land value information obtained from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation.

Awarding a Contract for the Courthouse Fire Alarm system Replacement and Amending the Facilities Management 2020 Budget

This resolution is to award two contracts for the fire alarm system replacement at the Courthouse. Rock County bid the equipment and installation separately for cost saving reasons.

This resolution approves contracting with the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder, Omni Technologies of Oregon, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$58,169 for the fire alarm system equipment.

This resolution also approves contracting with the lowest, most responsive and responsible bidder, Electric Construction Inc. of Madison, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$290,351 for the fire alarm system installation.

Lastly, this resolution requests a contingency fund of \$35,000 for any possible unforeseen items or issues. The total cost for the system with the contingency is \$383,520.

Funds in the amount of \$100,000 were budgeted for the fire alarm panel upgrade. Due to current code requirements and the need to improve system coverage, a panel upgrade would not be enough and a full replacement is required. Code also requires a fully functional system at all times. This requirement will add to the labor cost as we have to keep the old system up and running until the new system is completely installed and online. Once the new system is tested, the old system will be removed. A budget amendment is needed to apply \$283,520 from the general fund.


