## AMENDING HOUSING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH WISCONSIN PARTNERSHIP FOR HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND AMEND THE 2015 BUDGET

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This resolution would amend Services Contract No. 638667 with the Wisconsin Partnership for Housing Development for the delivery of administrative services for the Housing Division of the Planning & Development Department based upon the following:

- Rock County's Housing Division has been under increasing scrutiny for non-compliance with a variety of federal and/or state agency regulations.
- A summer 2013 report issued by the Wisconsin Department of Administration Division of Housing identified several areas of non-compliance. The State's report resulted in a suspension of funds until the County adequately addressed these findings.
- A monitoring of the HOME Consortium Rehabilitation Program resulted in a complete revision of the Housing Division's Policies and Procedures Manual.
- Multiple projects identified under the State's monitoring of Rock County's CDBG-Small Cities Grant Program were determined to require a greater extent of corrective action and management.
- Additional findings have been cited in other housing grant programs administered by Rock County (Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)-Small Cities – City of Edgerton, HOME Program, etc.) and have required additional time, consideration and resources to address.

The result of these collective elements is that the scope and resolution of grant management findings have required additional efforts by Wisconsin Partnership for Housing Development and has exceeded the agreed upon contracted payment amount.

#### **Executive Summary**

#### Aerial Work Platform - Rock County Jail Facility

The resolution before you awards the purchase of an aerial work platform to Wisconsin Lift Truck Corporation of Janesville WI. The purchase of the aerial work platform is to replace the facilities existing aerial work platform which is believed to have been purchased in 1990.

The company who produced the existing aerial work platform is no longer in business. The lift had experienced loss of specific operational functions. An attempt was made to repair the lift, however parts for the unit are obsolete, and no longer available. For safety reasons the lift has been taken out of service.

The replacement lift will ensure the continued maintenance of systems within the jail facility that require the use of an aerial work platform.

Delivery of the new lift is anticipated to be two weeks after receipt of order. Purchase also includes the removal and destruction of the facilities existing aerial work platform.

#### **Executive Summary**

#### Proposed Rock County Ordinance for Local Group Homes

Located in Rock County are privately operated youth and adult group homes. Youth group homes are licensed by the State of Wisconsin Department of Children & Families and adult group homes are licensed by the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services. Licensed group homes have the ability to accept residents from any county within the State of Wisconsin. Under Wisconsin State Law, when a county places a client outside of their respective jurisdiction, that placing county retains legal jurisdiction. Privately operated youth and adult group homes in Rock County often times provide temporary care of clients from other counties throughout Wisconsin.

Out-of-county clients, placed in privately operated group homes, can present challenges to local law enforcement and the Rock County Human Services Department. Often times out-of-county clients are unknown to law enforcement and Human Services. It is common for law enforcement to be called to these local group homes to deal with a crisis. When a crisis occurs with an out-of-county group home resident there is a lack of appropriate crisis plans to deal with residents from other counties. Due to crisis plans not being made available, it results in law enforcement expending significant amounts of time and resources dealing with out-of-county clients. Lack of client crisis plans also results in the unnecessary placement of out-of-county clients into the Rock County Youth Services Center and Rock County Jail. This proposed Ordinance will require each privately operated facility, accepting out-of-county clients, to provide the Human Services Department with an interjurisdicational agreement that facilitates crisis intervention services for out-of-county clients. Failure on the part of the privately operated facility to provide the Human Services Department with an interjurisdictional agreement would result in a monetary penalty.
