Executive Summary

Amending the 2019 Human Services Department Budget to accept a Quality Improvement Grant for Crisis Intervention Programs

This resolution authorizes HSD to accept \$20,000 from Wisconsin DHS in additional funds that are available through the Quality Improvement Grant Opportunity for Crisis Intervention Programs. HSD previously received \$20,000 of this funding to implement the Collaborative Assessment and Management of Suicide (CAMS) in December 2018.

The new funds will be used for additional CAMS consultation and to implement a telehealth psychiatry option in crisis and to purchase four mobile laptop devices. We recognize that clients in crisis can benefit, at times, from a medication adjustment or refill. Telehealth will allow us to provide a medication evaluation in a timely manner. We anticipate that this will support community-based safety planning and prevent some hospitalizations.

ENDORSING THE ACCEPTANCE OF MEDICAID EXPANSION FUNDS AND PLACING HEALTHCARE ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON THE SPRING 2020 COUNTY BALLOT

WHEREAS, the Affordable Care Act ("ACA") established a program of Medicaid expansion whereby in exchange for increased federal matching funds, states could elect to expand the number of individuals covered under state administered Medicaid programs; and,

WHEREAS, historically the State of Wisconsin has refused the Medicaid expansion funds created by the ACA; and,

WHEREAS, through the 2013-2015 biennium budget, the number of individuals covered by Wisconsin's Medicaid program was expanded to include certain childless adults with incomes at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level. This partial expansion increased coverage under the State's Medicaid program, but was insufficient to qualify for the increased federal reimbursement funds under the ACA; and

WHEREAS, Medicaid expansion funds continue to be available for states that elect to expand eligibility requirements, and would expand health insurance coverage to an additional 82,000 parents and childless adults; and,

WHEREAS, the Legislative Fiscal Bureau estimates that if the State moved to full expansion on January 1, 2020, the State of Wisconsin would save \$279,400,000 over the next biennium because the Federal government would pay over 90% of the costs of coverage for many current BadgerCare recipients; and,

WHEREAS, 19 counties, including Rock County, have passed resolutions urging Wisconsin to accept Medicaid expansion funds, a position that has been adopted by the Wisconsin Counties Association; and,

WHEREAS, currently 37 states, including the District of Columbia, have accepted Medicaid expansion, including all of Wisconsin's Midwestern neighbors – Iowa, Illinois, Minnesota, and Michigan.

WHEREAS, the decision to not accept federal Medicaid funds directly impacts the citizens of Wisconsin, and the voters of Rock County who should be able to provide an advisory opinion to support or oppose the acceptance of these Federal Medicaid funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this ____ day of _____, 2019 does hereby support and endorse the acceptance of Medicaid Expansion funds by the State and urges the legislature to accept such funds as a part of the 2019-2021 biennium budget.
