DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF APRIL 3 THROUGH APRIL 7, 2017 "WORK ZONE SAFETY AWARENESS WEEK IN ROCK COUNTY"

WHEREAS, in 1999, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) partnered with the American 1 Association of State Highway Officials (AASHTO) to create the National Work Zone Safety 2 Awareness Week campaign, held annually in April prior to the construction season in much of the 3 4 nation: and 5 WHEREAS, three (3) Wisconsin County Highway workers were killed in work zones 6 7 in 2015; and 8 WHEREAS, in a typical year, over one thousand people are killed in work zones 9 nationwide, either as drivers, passengers, or pedestrians; and 10 11 WHEREAS, in the past few years Wisconsin work zones have averaged 12 approximately 1,200 accidents annually and an average of 15 resulted in fatalities 13 14 per year; and 15 WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office, the Wisconsin State Patrol and Rock 16 County Highway Department are committed once again in 2017 to conduct enforcement 17 activities and work jointly to make "Work Zone Safety Awareness Week" a reminder of 18 the importance of everyone's safety in work zones; and 19
