EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY BY 30 DAYS DUE TO THE COVID 19 PANDEMIC

- WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, County Administrator Josh Smith and then Chair of the Rock County Board of Supervisors J. Russell Podzilni issued a Declaration of Local State of Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and,
 - WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020, the Rock Board of Supervisors acted by resolution to ratify the local state of emergency; and,
 - WHEREAS, the declaration of a local state of emergency allows County Administrator Smith to exercise emergency powers and issue administrative orders that are necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons and property within Rock County; and,
 - WHEREAS, to date, County Administrator Smith has issued administrative orders allowing for the continuity of government operations by the use of electronic meetings, policies to provide for federally protected under the FFCRA for County Employees, and establish a Temporary Leave Program for employees unable to work because of the "Safer at Home" order; and,
 - WHEREAS, the initial Declaration of Local State of Emergency was limited to 60 days and therefore expires on May 15, 2020; and,
 - WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to present a substantial threat to the health, safety and wellbeing of the Rock County, which currently has the ninth highest growth rate of Covid-19 cases in the country, according to data collected by the New York Times; and,
 - **WHEREAS**, it is still necessary and appropriate to provide County Administrator Smith the general authority to order, in consultation with the County Board Chair and subject to review by the Rock County Board of Supervisors, whatever is necessary and expedient for the health, safety, protection, and welfare of persons and property within Rock County during the emergency; and
 - WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 323 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Rock County Board of Supervisors has the power to extend the local state of emergency declared on March 16, 2020
 - **WHEREAS**, extension of the local state of emergency declared in Rock County on March 16, 2020 for a period of 30 days will continue to facilitate and expedite the use of resources to protect persons from the impacts of the spread of COVID-19 while ensuring the continuity of the critical operations of Rock County.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled 36 this 14th day of May, 2020 does hereby declare that pursuant to section 323.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes, 37 in light of the continued threat to the provisions of medical care and public health that is posed by COVID-38 19; to protect public peace, health, and safety; and to preserve the lives of property, economic stability; 39 and insure cooperation and coordination, that a local state of emergency continues to exists within Rock 40 County and as such, the Declaration of Local State of Emergency signed on March 16, 2020 shall be 41 extended for a period of 30 days, or until modified by further proclamation or further action of the Rock 42 County Board of Supervisors. 43
