3 4 5	WHEREAS, Rock County endorses a conservation ethic through various department initiatives which protect two of our most valuable and vulnerable environmental resources; and,
6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, as the county grows and changes, we must preserve the quality of the soil and water for future generations; and,
10 11 12	WHEREAS, the County adopted the Land and Water Resource Management Plan during their August 13, 2009 County Board meeting; and,
13 14 15	WHEREAS, the Land and Water Resource Management Plan serves as the primary plan for the conservation of the county's natural resources, mainly its soil and water resources; and,
16 17 18 19 20	WHEREAS, the Land Conservation Department protects our soil and water resources through a variety of programs, including Farmland Preservation Program, Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easements, Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program, Animal Waste Management Program, Storm Water Management Program, Construction Site Erosion Control Program, Clean Sweep, and the Land and Water Resource Management Program; and,
21 22 23 24	WHEREAS, the Public Health Department protects our soil and water resources through overseeing of private sewage disposal systems, unused well abandonment program, surface water quality sampling, drinking water testing programs, and the prescription drug roundup; and,
25 26 27 28 29	WHEREAS, the Planning Economic and Community Development Agency protects our soil and water resources through the administration of shoreland zoning and floodplain management and the establishment of conservation easements through the land division ordinance; and,
30 31 32	WHEREAS, the UW Extension protects our soil and water resources through pesticide applicator training, education, and nutrient management research; and,
33 34 35	WHEREAS, the mentioned departments work together on many programs that monitor, regulate, plan, educate, and assist citizens with the goal of natural resource and environmental protection.
37	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this day of, 2010 does hereby support and promote eco-friendly practices in the county which preserve or improve the quality of water and soil for future generations, and affirm the work
