

The house is 90 years old. It is on a low spot on the property and surrounding properties. The basement has dirt / limestone walls. It was flooded during 2008, which is evident on the walls. Apparently, the water table has risen, because the basement has been at least damp ever since. The electrical service is in the basement. Its boxes have signs of rust. The service needs to be moved and brought into compliance with the Electrical Code. The septic system has not worked since the 2008 flood. The drainfield is saturated. The system has been cited for failure by the Health Department. The owners have had the tank pumped 5 times. The project proposes to have basement repairs conducted: Replacing damaged beams, installation of concrete block walls and a concrete floor. A floor drain will be installed. The sump pump will be replaced. The electrical services will be replaced with a 200 AMP service panel. Extensive rewiring and installation of GFI outlets will be conducted to bring the house & property into compliance with the Electrical Code. The septic system will be replaced with a conventional system. Conducting this project is in compliance with CDBG-EAP requirements and will address several major health and safety hazard for this and surrounding properties. It will bring the property into compliance with the Rock County Health Dept. and local electrical Codes. 
