#### CONDITIONS TO BE MET BEFORE ROCK COUNTY FINAL APPROVAL:

- 1. Existing structures shall meet setback regulations.
- 2. 35-foot 1/2 ROW to be dedicated along Philhower Rd.
- 3. Following notation on final map: "Since Lot 1 contains existing buildings which utilize an existing private sewage system no soil evaluation on the lot was required at the time of this survey. However, soils on the lot may be restrictive to the replacement of the existing system." Also proposed lot lines must include the system area with the building that utilizes the system.
- 4. Final CSM (1 year time frame) submitted to and approved by the Planning and Development Agency on or before March 10, 2012.
- 5. As per Section 15.23(8) of The Rock County Land Division Regulations "any land division not receiving final approval within the period of time set forth herein shall be null and void, and the developer shall be required to resubmit a new application for preliminary approval. Extensions may be applied for and may be granted at the discretion of the Committee upon findings that delays are beyond control of the applicant and that no material change in

standards or in conditions has occurred or is reasonably expected to occur".	Extension
requests must be made in writing prior to the expiration date listed above.	

6. Certified Survey Maps that are subject to local approval must be recorded within 6 months of their last approval and 24 months of the first approval.



The house is 50 years old. It is on a low spot on the property and surrounding properties. The basement has poured concrete walls. It was flooded during 2008, which is evident on the walls. The water table has risen, because water has continued to leak into the basement. The basement walls and ducts need to be disinfected. In addition, the 4 basement window wells have many rotted structures. Fill needs to be added around the house to keep surface water from flowing toward the foundation. The on-site sewerage system is original to the house and was constructed before current septic system regulations were enacted. The tank is undersized. During the 2008 flood, sewage from the tank backed up into the house. The drainfield is saturated, and effluent has flowed to the surface several times. The system has to be pumped regularly. A septic system in compliance with current septic system regulations needs to be installed. The project proposes to have a full perimeter flood-resistant basement water containment system installed around the perimeter of the basement walls. The basement walls and ductwork will be thoroughly disinfected. The basement window structures will be replaced, and 4 new basement windows will be installed. Fill will be added around the foundation to direct water away from the foundation. The project will also have the soil evaluation conducted for installation of a Code-compliant septic system. Conducting this project will correct several storm-damaged items, and correct several health and safety hazards. ## AUTHORIZING WISCONSIN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOMENT (CDBG-ED) APPLICATION

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

#### Prepared by James R. Otterstein, Economic Development Manager

Federal block grant appropriations made available to the State of Wisconsin, for economic development purposes are administered by the Wisconsin Department of Commerce. Through Commerce's Community Development Block Grant for Economic Development (CDBG-ED) program, funds are awarded to a general-purpose unit of government (i.e. community) - who in turn – grants and/or loans the funds to eligible businesses. Eligibility is determined according to private investment commitments and the creation and/or retention of full-time employment positions. CDBG-ED funds can be used to finance the following activities: business acquisitions; buildings / land purchases; construction expenditures; machinery / equipment purchases; training and working capital expenses.

Per the Wisconsin Department of Commerce agreement, a CDBG-ED loan up to \$750,000 will be provided to Rock County, which in turn will provide the funds to Stoughton Trailers, LLC (i.e. the Borrower) for equipment and training related expenditures. Rock County (i.e. the Economic Development Agency) will serve as the CDBG-ED administrative and fiscal agent. For its services, Rock County will receive a \$6,000 administrative fee. Thus, the total CDBG-ED application requests a funding level in the amount up to \$756,000

Per the Department's agreement, repayments and/or fees collected from the Borrower will be retained by Rock County and used to capitalize its countywide Revolving Loan Fund (RLF). The RLF, which is administered by Rock County's Economic Development Agency under the provisions established within the RLF Policies and Procedures Manual, provides financial assistance to eligible businesses seeking to expand, locate or start-up within Rock County.
