Executive Summary

Amending the 2020 Human Services Department Budget to Accept a COVID Behavioral Health Grant

Rock County Human Services Department has been awarded a SAMHSA grant through the Wisconsin Department of Health Services in the amount of \$212,702 to be used by August 31, 2021. This resolution seeks approval from the Board to accept the grant award.

The grant provides funding in the areas of peer specialist programming, support for First Responders in Rock County, and access to safe and sober housing. This funding supplements a partnership with Rock Valley Community Programs by adding 1.4 FTE to the existing peer specialist program. The grant also provides funding for the Rock County Sheriff's Office to oversee a coordinator who will organize and manage the Critical Incident Stress Management process among First Responders in Rock County. Finally, funding will support citizens who need assistance to secure safe and secure housing.
