## **PROCLAIMING MAY 2010 DRUG COURT MONTH**

1	WHEREAS, Drug Courts are the most effective tool for reducing substance abuse and crime in our
2	criminal justice system; and,

WHEREAS, for the past 21 years Drug Courts have been restoring lives, reuniting families and making communities across this nation safer; and,

WHEREAS, Drug Courts provide focus and leadership for community-wide partnerships, bringing together public safety and public health professionals in the fight against drug abuse and criminality; and,

WHEREAS, results of more than 100 program evaluations and at least four meta-analytic studies have yielded definitive evidence that Drug Courts are demonstratively effective and significantly improve

substance-abuse treatment outcomes, substantially reduce drug abuse and crime, and do so at less expense than any other justice strategy; and,

WHEREAS, over 27,000 judges, prosecutors, defense attorneys, substance abuse and rehabilitation professionals, law enforcement and community supervision personnel, researchers and educators, national and community leaders, and others dedicated to Drug Courts and similar types of treatment programs are healing families and communities across the country; and,

WHEREAS, the Drug Court movement has grown from 12 original Drug Courts in 1994 to 2,400 operational Drug Courts; and,

23 WHEREAS, the time has come to put a Drug Court within reach of every person in need; and,

WHEREAS, Rock County started its Drug Court in April 2007 and has had 87 successful graduations as of April 15, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, Thursday, May 20, 2010 marks *National Drug Court Commencement Day*, which celebrates the promise of recovery and restored hope to Drug Court graduates and their families.
