1 2	WHEREAS, the County of Rock is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and
3 4 5 6 7 8	WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers covered by the Act either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers authorized to do business in Wisconsin, or to be exempted (self-insured) from insuring liabilities with a carrier and thereby assuming the responsibility for its own worker's compensation risk and payment; and WHEREAS, the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's compensation
9 10 11 12	without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development (Department) if they agree to report faithfully all compensible injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department;
13 14 15 16	WHEREAS, it is in the County's best interest to approve the continuation of the self-insured worker's compensation program, in compliance with Wisconsin Administrative Code DWD 80.60(3); and
17 18 19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this <u>8</u> day of <u>March</u> , 2012, that the County Board:
