

FINANCE COMMITTEE Minutes – August 16, 2018

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, August 16, 2018, in Conference Room N-1, Courthouse East.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>. Supervisors Mawhinney, Beaver, Podzilni and Yeomans.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Ms. Oja said a transfer was handed out for Land Information. Supervisor Yeomans moved approval of the agenda as presented, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements. None.

Review and Comments on the 2017 Certified Audit – Baker Tilly Virchow Krause, LLP. Ms. Oja handed out the Financial Statements, Communications to Those Charged with Governance and Management, and Report to the Finance Committee.

Ms. Jansen said theirs is an unmodified opinion, which is at the highest assurance level they can provide.

Ms. Jansen and Ms. Acker went over the *Report to the Finance Committee* and explained the reports and their supporting Financial Statement schedules. Ms. Jansen said this is the first year without Developmental Disabilities Board. Ms. Jansen and Ms. Acker said the County continues to be in a healthy position, that the County is stable and in good shape, there are no concerns in the debt service funds, the analysis of the General Fund Balance Trends is very stable and healthy, the comparison of funds is more in line now with the policy changes made last year, the percentage of debt limit is under 10% which is very healthy, and Rock County has had a very healthy year overall.

Ms. Jansen and Ms. Acker went over the *Communication to Those Charged with Governance and Management*. Ms. Jansen said there are a number of areas in the Information Technology department, but with the upcoming IT Department audit these should hopefully be addressed. There are also some controls for bank wire transfers and outstanding checks in the Treasurer's office needing to be strengthened/addressed. Bank reconciliations for the Sheriff's office and Rock Haven need to have policies updated and maybe help from the Finance office.

Ms. Jansen said they are also recommending Rock Haven perform a lookback analysis of outstanding patient billings on a regular basis throughout the year. The highway general ledger and accounts receivable reconciliations and year-end entries need to be done on a more-timely basis.

Ms. Jansen said vendor fraud is a unique threat to governments due to the transparent nature of operations and suggested putting safety and control measures in place to help protect the County.

Ms. Jansen and Ms. Acker thanked the Committee and staff and said the County is in a healthy, stable position and the trending has been good.

Approval of Minutes – August 2, 2018, August 6, 2018 and Joint with County Board Staff Committee from July 23, 2018. Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of the minutes of July 23, 2018, August 2, 2018 and August 6, 2018 as presented, second by Supervisor Yeomans. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Yeomans moved approval of the request to sell the AC units and the funds go for the Rock Haven residents activities, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Properties and Auction</u> The Committee went over the list and discussed a number of properties and felt meetings with both the City of Beloit and City of Janesville are needed to discuss the consequences of the County taking some of these properties. Also discussed the need to clean up some of the split properties before they go to auction.

Supervisor Yeomans moved holding properties #9-#13 from foreclosure until there can be a meeting with the City of Janesville, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Yeomans moved to hold property #18 from foreclosure until there can be a meeting with City of Beloit, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Podzilni moved to set the prices on the properties, other than the ones they put on hold, as listed on the sheet handed out (attached), second by Supervisor Yeomans. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Yeomans asked about the fees being charged and asked if they need to be changed. Ms. Roettger said they may be set by State Statute and she would look into it.

Adjournment. Supervisor Podzilni moved adjournment at 8:58 A.M., second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.
