Supervisor Podzilni moved Committee approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Kraft.

Mr. Leu said they tried to scale back on this \$1.17 million project as much as possible and are hoping to complete it by the fall 2016. He said the executive summary provides a good overview of the project.

ADOPTED.

Request to Donate Abandoned Bicycles to Brian and Anne Reece of Beloit, WI.

Supervisor Beaver moved approval to donate the abandoned bicycles to Brian and Anne Reece, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Review, Discussion and Recommended Revisions to the 2016 Recommended Budget.

Ms. Oja handed out a spreadsheet on recommendations for amending the 2016 Recommended Budget (attached) and went over it.

Supervisor Podzilni moved to accept these changes and put in the 2016 Recommended Budget, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

Ms. Oja went over the changes due to receiving a lower rate and additional premium funds on the debt sale.

Supervisor Kraft moved approval of these changes to the 2016 Recommended Budget, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Beaver asked about the costs involved to keep the Evansville congregate meal site open in 2016. Mr. Smith said the breakdown is: \$12,000 for the site manager; \$2,400 for rent; \$7,337 cost of meals; and \$1,000 for paper goods.

The committee discussed reducing the days the site would be open; differences between keeping the site open and home delivered; using the school district for meals; asking Creekside to reduce or eliminate rent; what the site manager does and if it could be done with volunteers; if more advertising would help increase attendance; and the socializing aspect of meals at the site.

Chair Mawhinney and the Finance Committee said this is a good budget and they appreciate all the work staff has put into it.

<u>Adjournment</u>. Supervisor Podzilni moved adjournment at 8:29 A.M., second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.
