Wisconsin GI Bill Update Chair Wiedenfeld read the e-mail from Mr. Solis letting the Committee know about AB781, which will actually hurt the veterans if it becomes law. AB781 will allow the schools to reduce WI GI Bill benefits regardless of the school the veteran attends. There is a question as to whether this is legal so the bill may not become law for that reason. The Committee requested Mr. Solis draft a resolution opposing AB781.

American Legion Birthday Month Chair Wiedenfeld read the e-mail from Mr. Solis letting the Committee know that March is American Legion Birthday Month. Orfordville Post 209 had their dinner the past Saturday and Janesville Post 205 will be holding theirs on Tuesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>.
