# PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE COMMITTEE Minutes – January 7, 2013

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Collins called the meeting of the Public Safety and Justice Committee to order at 4:00 P.M. on December 3, 2012 in the Conference Room N-1 at the Rock County Courthouse - East.

Adoption of Agenda. Chair Collins said item 7 as a resolution is needed. Supervisor Brill moved approval of the agenda with this deletion, second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.

Adoption of Minutes. Supervisor Wiedenfeld moved approval of the minutes of December 3, 2012, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, Announcement, Information.</u> Mr. Farrell reported the suicide prevention video has had over 10,000 views, this does not include the parts of the video other counties and international associations are using. "Survivors of Suicide" has also expanded throughout the County. Mr. Farrell said they had expected, based on past trends, to have about 40 suicide cases in 2012 and they have had 21 local cases. He said they are continuing working with schools regarding suicide and other tragedies.

Supervisor Wiedenfeld asked how many cases of suicide are related to drugs and/or alcohol. Mr. Farrell said 72% have shown alcohol use and 12% have shown use of mixed narcotics.
