<u>Proposal for a Coroner Morgue.</u> Ms. Keach handed out copies of the Coroner's Office proposal for a morgue at the Health Care Center utilizing the existing coolers and freezer. Ms. Keach said the proposal includes air quality issues, anticipated costs, and a possible future grant.

Supervisor Knudson requested the proposal be given to the General Services Committee for their input.

Supervisor Brill asked what the cost comparison would be to using Mercy Hospital. Ms. Keach said Mercy does not charge anything unless they did an autopsy and then they charge \$100.00. She added that there is no way for the Coroner's Office to secure the Mercy site.

<u>First Quarter 2013 Activity Report – Mediation and Family Court Services.</u> Ms. Costrini-Norgal went over the report and answered the Committee's questions regarding the report. Supervisor Knudson complimented Ms. Costrini-Norgal on the thoroughness of the report.

Chair Collins asked Ms. Costrini-Norgal how 2013 is comparing to previous years. Ms. Costrini-Norgal said the numbers are about the same but the sessions are becoming meaner and nastier. Chair Collins asked if she feels secure during the meetings. Ms. Costrini-Norgal said the Sheriff staff does a good job on making their presence known and that she has been reassured that the Courthouse Security Committee is working on tighter security.
