Annual Report – 911 Communications Center. Mr. Sleeter went over the highlights of the 911 Communications Center Annual Report. Staff has had 1,611 hours of training; the quality assurance cards sent back usually come back at 95%; the 2010 Public Education Program they made 40-50 presentations to schools, churches, etc. and a number of billboards have been

placed around the county; they received CALEA accreditation again in 2010, they are the second in the U.S. to achieve this and the first in Wisconsin. Mr. Sleeter said they are answering 96.36% of the calls coming in between 1-10 seconds, and they had 410,000 calls in and out of the Center, which is down a little from 2009. They averaged 749 calls per day that required action in 2010, which is an 8.7% increase in activity.

Supervisor Brill thanked Mr. Sleeter and staff for the 4-H Fair game presentation they had, the kids really enjoyed it and they learned a lot.

<u>Program FY 2011 Local Solicitation Application.</u> Captain Groelle said they have received this grant for the past 3 – 4 years and have used it for the patrol division. This year they purchased cameras and investigative tools.

Chair Collins said he has a copy of the full grant application if anyone wished to see it.

Ms. Pohlman McQuillen said she heard a grant is available to apply for today and is due in one month. She added that she will be coming back to this Committee for approval to apply.

<u>Semi-Annual Reports.</u> The Committee accepted the reports from the Courts, 911 Communications Center, Clerk of Circuit Court, Emergency Management, and Mediation and Family Court Services and directed they be placed in file.

Committee Requests and Motions.

<u>Discussion on Department Tours</u> Chair Collins said the tour of the Sheriff's Office will be October 10th.

Supervisor Brill said he heard that RECAP is not as available to help with projects. Captain Groelle said they have been getting a great many requests and they are going out a lot. He said he would have Captain Fell check into this. Chair Collins said they would add this to a future agenda.

Chair Collins asked about the security cameras in the Courthouse parking lots. Supervisor Brill said he thought it was too expensive to do. Supervisor Beaver said she thought it went to the General Services Committee. Supervisor Brill said he would check with the General Services Committee at their next meeting August 2nd.

Adjournment. Supervisor Beaver moved adjournment at 4:26 P.M., second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.
