<u>Adoption of Agenda</u>. Supervisor Knudson moved approval of the agenda as presented, second by Supervisor Brill. ADOPTED.

Supervisor Knudson moved approval of the above Consent Calendar for the Public Safety & Justice Committee, second by Supervisor Brill. ADOPTED.

<u>Update on Slow-no-Wake – Corporation Counsel.</u> Mr. Kuglitsch said he had sent copies of the draft ordinance from the Lake District to the Sheriff, PS&J Committee, and the cities and towns this affects. Both Mr. Kuglitsch and the Sheriff feel, for the most part, it is okay; the City of Beloit and Town of Janesville both feel it is okay; the Town of Fulton feels the 9.0 feet, under Section 5.(A) is too much and requested it be 7 feet 5 inches. Mr. Kuglitsch said he would put that in for the Newville site.

Mr. Kuglitsch asked the Committee if they would like him to make this change for the Newville site and draft an official ordinance for the next meeting, and have it go to the July or August County Board meeting for the first reading.

Supervisor Wiedenfeld suggested Mr. Kuglitsch send something to the non-responsive towns to let them know that if they don't speak by a designated date it will be adopted as presented to the County Board. Mr. Kuglitsch said he will send the draft out to them with the dates of the hearings, etc. and for them to get back to him with any questions and/or concerns they have.

Supervisor Wiedenfeld said in the draft document it says "gage" a number of times, do they mean "gauge". Mr. Kuglitsch said he believes gauge would be correct.

Supervisor Kraft said on Memorial Day the river was higher due to the increased activity. She asked if something could be put in for the slow-no-wake at the discretion of the Sheriff for times of increased activity. Mr. Kuglitsch agreed that at various times of the day the water level could be at different elevations and there should be something in the ordinance to address this.

Supervisor Podzilni said his concern is that in the past it has been in the newspapers that the Sheriff was requested to place the slow-no-wake by the town or city and it should be the Sheriff has placed a slow-no wake. Mr. Kuglitsch agreed that the Sheriff needs to be the agent.

Supervisor Knudson moved to have Mr. Kuglitsch proceed with the draft ordinance and bring it to the next meeting, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.
