<u>Courthouse Security</u>. Mr. O'Leary said the Courthouse Security Committee, chaired by Judge Bates, has been meeting to discuss ways to improve the security within the courthouse. He said there have been two narrow misses for a couple Bailiffs. One of the Bailiffs did end up with a broken ankle and the other Judge Fitzpatrick was on his way down from the bench to help the other Bailiff. He said there are no videos of these instances because there are still issues with the cameras. He added that the Sheriff's Office has done an excellent study with a full proposal. The Committee is in the process of looking for grant money. Mr. O'Leary said we need to make sure we keep the citizens and staff safe.

Report on Digital Radio Conversion. Ms. Sukus informed the Committee that the county went to digital on June 27<sup>th</sup>. The Edgerton Fire Department had some issues with coverage; they did some changes with the antenna, which has helped a bit. The Janesville Police started having problems, as did the State Patrol, and they found some issues with the software, which General Communications is working on. Then the system crashed the prior day, they called everyone in and it was decided that many of them would go back to analog until the software issues are worked out. Ms. Sukus said that General Communications and Raytheon are working diligently on correcting the issues.
