Chair Collins informed Mr. Wilson that the County is planning on going out, by Sheriff's boat, and looking at the lower and upper portions of the river to see if any changes are needed, possibly as early as next week.

Mr. Kuglitsch said another meeting of this Committee would be needed for discussion after the upcoming tour. This information would then go to County Board as an amendment to the ordinance for a first reading and then for adoption.

Proposed Language for Amendment of Slow No Wake Ordinance

25.50 SPEED RESTRICTIONS

(B) No person shall operate a boat or watercraft at greater than Slow-No-Wake Speed on any portion of the Rock River downstream from the Indianford Dam to *the West B-R Town Line Road Bridge* when the gauge water level at the US Geological Survey gauge 05430500 (Rock River at Afton, Wisconsin) is above 6.5 feet. This information can be obtained from the NOAA website.

(G) No person shall operate a boat or watercraft at greater than Slow-No-Wake Speed on any portion of the Rock River downstream from the West B-R Town Line Road Bridge to the southern Rock County line when the gauge water level at the US Geological Survey gauge 05430500 (Rock River at Afton, Wisconsin) is above 8.5 feet.
