Council on Aging

<u>County Senior Statesmanship Program</u> Ms. Lubben handed out a summary of the evaluations on the program. They had many good comments from the attendees.

Veterans Services

<u>CVSO Fall Conference</u> Mr. Solis reported he had attended the fall CVSO conference in Port Washington and had some very good training. He was nominated as the Second Vice President, which means he will most likely move up to President in two years. This means the conference will be held in Rock County.

Retired and Senior Volunteer Program

<u>Seniors Helping Seniors Program Update</u> Mr. Harlow said he has had two meetings in Beloit and one in Janesville with the volunteer groups to go over the rules, etc. of the program. He said they are actively recruiting volunteers and will also be hiring a part-time staff person. He said that Ms. Lubben has volunteered to help in getting the forms together, how to sort who gets what and who goes where. They are also working on the background checks.

Budget Review

<u>Council on Aging</u> Ms. Lubben said her requests pretty much mirror Mr. Knutson's recommendations. The only change will be the funds going to the Senior Helping Senior program instead of Senior Companion.

Ms. Lubben handed out a County Response to Mr. Johnson, President, Beloit Meals on Wheels comments to the County Board on October 14th. She went over the report she and Mr. Terronez put together and said that the 2011 Recommended Budget brings the funding allocation for the entire County more in line with the actual numbers of meals being provided.

Heritage Rock County No one was present from Heritage Rock County.

Retired Senior Volunteer Program Mr. Harlow said there were no surprises and did not have any further requests.

UW Rock County Dean Pillard said the projects listed are fine.

<u>Veterans Services</u> Mr. Solis said there were no surprises and he did not have any further requests.
