Council on Aging – Joyce Lubben

"Burden of Falls" Report Ms. Lubben handed out copies of *The Burden of Falls in Wisconsin*, which is a summary of the past eight to nine years study of falls. She said Wisconsin is the second highest state with deaths due to falls, behind New Mexico. It is important to have active seniors take a class like *Steppin' On* to learn about what they can do to help guard against falls.

<u>County Senior Statesmanship Program</u> Ms. Lubben handed out copies of the flier on the 2010 County Senior Statesmanship Program. The program will be held on September 23rd and 24th this year at Rotary Gardens. She encouraged everyone to attend.

<u>Caregiver Coalition Grant</u> Ms. Lubben handed out the half page flier requesting caregivers to complete a survey either by phone, website or mail. This survey will help ensure family caregivers will get the help they need.

<u>New Freedom Application</u> Ms. Lubben said she is applying for this transportation grant. She would like to see if they would be able to get a Mobility Manager to help coordinate transportation in Rock County.

<u>Committee Requests and Motions.</u> Chair Thomas thanked Dean Pillard for hosting the meeting at UW – Rock County.

<u>Ideas for Future Discussion</u> Chair Thomas asked Ms. Lubben if she would like to host a meeting at the Council on Aging Office. The Committee agreed on the November meeting. Ms. Lubben said she would check on the meeting room.
