Executive Summary

Authorizing Purchase of Two Bladder Scans and One Cart for Rock Haven

As we plan for our move into the new Rock Haven facility this fall, it is important to recognize that the design of the building creates two distinct resident care areas, Limestone and Sandstone Courts. In order to be staff efficient, it is necessary to provide necessary medical equipment to both areas.

Nurses at Rock Haven have used a Bladder Scan for years and have been pleased with the ease of use of the BVI Scans. The BVI 3000 Bladder Scan provides the latest version for us. We will be able to reuse the current cart, allowing us to budget for only one replacement cart.

The two BVI 3000 Bladder Scan (item # 75125) and cart (item # 75132) will be purchased through Direct Supply, a sole source provider of this product. Their quote (#10117447) lists a cost of \$10,879 per scan and \$468.99 per cart for a total cost of \$22,226.99.
