EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Jail Renovation Project affected the exterior lighting of the Rock County Sheriff/Jail area. During the initial portion of the project, five light poles and two signs were temporarily disconnected from the Sheriff/Jail building and connected to the Youth Services Center. Several months ago, options for addressing the exterior lighting issue were brought before the General Services Committee. After several discussions, the General Services Committee upon the recommendation of the Samuels Group, separated this activity from the main project and dealt with it as a standalone project.

The Samuels Group prepared the bid specifications and worked with County Purchasing to bid out this work. Four vendors responded to the bid notice (results attached).

The recommendation is to award the contract to Foley Electric of Beloit, Wisconsin in the amount of \$11,375 with funds to come from available Jail/Health Care Center Complex Capital Projects Account budget resources.
