Executive Summary

The Sheriff's Office was awarded an additional \$2,500 grant from the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program, bringing the total grant to \$59,500. The HIDTA program is administered by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP).

The purpose of the HIDTA Program is to reduce drug trafficking and drug production in the United States. The HIDTA Program provides funding resources to joint initiatives of federal, state, local, and tribal agencies in each area designated as a HIDTA to carry out activities that address the specific drug threats of those areas.

The additional grant funds will be used for investigative expenses.

WHEREAS, the Rock County Sheriff's Office has promulgated certain policies, procedures and general orders designed to hold its employees and officers to standards of professional conduct; and

WHEREAS, General Order 4.020 of the Rock County Sheriff establishes a code of ethics for law enforcement officers which states "I will never act officiously or permit personal feelings, prejudices, animosities, or friendships to influence my decisions;" and

WHEREAS, Rock County Sheriff's Office General Order 4.060 establishes general rules of conduct for all members of the Rock County Sheriff's Office, and such rules of conduct proscribe officers from personal activities or associations that knowingly create an apparent or real conflict of interest where "the officer's private interest, whether financial or otherwise, conflicts with the officer's impartial conduct of official duties and responsibilities;" and

WHEREAS, the Janesville Police Department opened an investigation of an incident on August 14, 2017 involving the injury of a young adult during an alleged "underage drinking party," at which residence, Sheriff Spoden's son may have been present earlier in the day; and

WHEREAS, officers from the Janesville Police Department were tasked with speaking with witnesses and the family members of witnesses who were reported to be at the residence where the incident occurred; and

WHEREAS, on August 21, 2017 Sheriff Spoden contacted an officer of the Janesville Police Department by text message, and in that communication suggested that the Janesville Police Department should end its investigation into the incident; and

WHEREAS, such communication creates the appearance that Sheriff Spoden was attempting to influence an investigation in which his son may have been a witness; and

WHEREAS, by engaging in such communication Sheriff Spoden has violated the Mission Statement, Code of Ethics, and Standards of Conduct adopted by the Rock County Sheriff's Office, and through his conduct violated the public trust of the citizens of Rock County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors, duly assembled this _____ day of ______, 2018 does hereby censure Robert Spoden, Sheriff of Rock County for his conduct in this matter.
