

FINANCE COMMITTEE Minutes – August 3, 2017

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, August 3, 2017, in Conference Room N-1, Courthouse East.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>. Supervisors Mawhinney, Kraft, Beaver, Fox and Podzilni.

Committee Members Excused: None.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Supervisor Fox moved approval of the amended agenda as presented, second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements.</u> Ms. Oja said she received a letter from the IRS regarding the audit and there were no penalties.

<u>Approval of Minutes – July 20, 2017.</u> Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of the minutes of July 20, 2017 as presented, second by Supervisor Kraft. ADOPTED.

Review and Comments on the 2016 Certified Audit – Baker Tilly Virchow Krause, LLP. Ms. Oja handed out the Financial Statements, Communications to Those Charged with Governance and Management, and Report to the Finance Committee.

Ms. Jansen said their opinion was the same as the prior year, which is at the highest assurance level they can provide.

Ms. Jansen went over the *Report to the Finance Committee* and explained the reports and their supporting Financial Statement schedules. Ms. Oja said there were a few changes due to the closing of the Developmental Disabilities Board. Ms. Jansen said the County continues to be in a healthy position, that the County is stable and in good shape compared to many other counties.

Ms. Jansen went over the *Communication to Those Charged with Governance and Management*. She said the highway account reconciliations need to be done on a more-timely basis. Ms. Jansen said Rock Haven has allowance for doubtful accounts established and these need to be reconciled periodically throughout the year.

Ms. Jansen said, from an audit standpoint, Rock County's financial position is very favorable with no current concerns.

Ms. Jansen thanked Ms. Oja, and all the County staff for their cooperation.

<u>Committee Review and Approval of Per Meeting Allowances.</u> Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of per meeting allowances in the amount of \$11,933.79, second by Supervisor Kraft. ADOPTED.

<u>Discussion and Possible Action on Ending DMV Services at the Courthouse.</u> Ms. Tollefson informed the Committee they have been doing renewals and some other, very limited, services. Last year this service only brought in \$78 and there are 21 other locations in the area who also do these services and more.

Supervisor Fox moved approval to end DMV services at the Courthouse, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Program.</u> Ms. Disrud explained the program to the Committee. This Fidlar sponsored program is free and would not take any of their time, other than a few phone calls, as it is done online. This would give people peace of mind and just requires a link on their web page.

Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of this program, second by Supervisor Fox. ADOPTED.

Adjournment. Supervisor Beaver moved adjournment at 8:05 A.M., second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.
