In addition, for claims expected over \$150,000 and for other specific injuries an additional fee of \$2,550 per claim may be charged. If the claim would ultimately close for less than \$150,000, Willis HRH Wisconsin would adjust the fee to the appropriate rate. Other ancillary services may be provided by Willis HRH Wisconsin provided all services are approved by the County prior to the acquisition of those services."

Mr. Kuglitsch said, based on everything they have seen so far, they recommend Willis. Mr. Smith added that Mr. Knutson also recommends the fee schedule.
