do this. Ms. Lubben said this is a position funded by grant funds and she can apply each year for the grant.

Ms. Knutson said they need to have a Transportation Plan written as well as having an implementation plan in place. The concern is that there are transportation vehicles at other facilities, such as Riverfront, that sit much of the time and these vehicles could be put to better use during these down times. This is an attempt to take assets in the community and utilize them for the better good of the community.

Ms. Lubben said the Transportation Coordinating Committee has a list of all transportation vehicles in the county and the Mobility Manager would work on bringing everyone together to make better use of the vehicles, to get cooperative agreements and work on getting rid of any barriers that may be there.

Mr. Knutson added that this is much different from a privately run company which owns all of the vehicles. This position would coordinate many different entities. Ms. Lubben added they would also look at where and when clients are being picked up and dropped off and coordinate the routes as well.
