FINANCE COMMITTEE October 7, 2010

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, October 7, 2010, in Conference Room N-1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>. Supervisors Mawhinney, Kraft, Beaver, Podzilni and Diestler.

Approval of Agenda. Mr. Smith informed the Committee that the Resolution awarding the contract for the audit of County books was re-titled to read "Awarding Contract for Financial Audit of County Books for Calendar Years 2010-2012 (With Options for 2013-2015)" and line 4 to read "Chair of the Finance Committee" instead of Supervisor Mawhinney. Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of the agenda with these changes, second by Supervisor Diestler. ADOPTED with these changes.

<u>Committee Review and Approval of Per Meeting Allowances.</u> Supervisor Beaver moved approval of Per Meeting Allowances in the amount of \$13,047.94, second by Supervisor Diestler. ADOPTED.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Supervisor Kraft moved approval of the minutes of September 16, 2010 as presented, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, Announcements, Information.</u> Mr. Smith said the Recommended 2011 Rock County Budget will be presented at the October 14th County Board meeting, the governing committees will hear from the various departments the weeks of October 18th and 25th, and suggested the Finance Committee hear consideration of changes to the 2011 budget from the Committee Chairs at the November 4th meeting. The Committee was in agreement of this.

Mr. Crittenden said the telephone audit has saved the County about \$27,000 with more to come as approximately \$9,000 is still in dispute.

Supervisor Kraft said Sheriff Spoden and staff gave a PowerPoint presentation at the WCA Conference in Milwaukee and, in talking to one of the Sergeants, learned that the presentation had to be done on a personal laptop instead of a County one and wondered why. Mr. Crittenden said he may have started the presentation on his personal laptop and the version of PowerPoint he used may have been a higher version than the County is running. Ms. Michaelis added that they did not have

a laptop available this year and the Sergeant felt more comfortable creating the presentation and presenting it on his own laptop.

Supervisor Mawhinney said the real estate tax foreclosure auction will be October 15th at 9 A.M. and there are 21 parcels left from the 54 we started with.
