FINANCE COMMITTEE® Minutes –August 6, 2015

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Monday, August 6, 2015, in Conference Room N-1 County Courthouse East.

Committee Members Present. Supervisors Mawhinney, Kraft and Fox.

Approval of Agenda. Supervisor Fox moved approval of the amended agenda, second by Supervisor Kraft. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements.</u> Ms. Brown said today is the last day to pay the 2011 taxes and they are down to 50 at this time. She added that she will be coming before the Committee soon with a written policy change regarding the holding of postdated checks.

<u>Approval of Minutes – July 2, 2015.</u> Chair Mawhinney said she had a couple changes to the minutes: page 1 staff member Lisa Furseth should be Lisa <u>Tollefson</u>; and page 2 should be "contingent <u>on</u>" not of. Supervisor Kraft moved approval of the minutes of July 2, 2015 with these changes, second by Supervisor Fox. ADOPTED.

Review and Comments on the 2014 Certified Audit – Baker Tilley Virchow Krause,
LLP. Ms. Oja handed out the Financial Statements, Communications to Those Charged with
Governance and Management, and Report to the Finance Committee.

Ms. Jansen went over the *Communication to Those Charged with Governance and Management*. She said the changes to GASB 67 and 68 will be affecting the County this year. She said GASB 68 will have a significant impact on the financial statements but they will work with the County.

Ms. Jansen said Financial Statements are at the highest assurance level they can provide.

Ms. Acker went over the *Report to the Finance Committee* and explained the reports and their supporting Financial Statement schedules. She said the County continues to be in a healthy position, that the County is stable and in good shape compared to many other counties.

Ms. Acker said the County may need to revisit the policy for Working Capital and Fund Balance as the County's percentage of working capital and fund balance to expenditures, the

combined funds is 21.83%, which is above the 10% - 17% range. The County's debt outstanding is at 8.67%, down from the prior two years. She said bond rating agencies recommend the ratio of debt service payments to non-capital expenditures be less than 16.67%. Rock County is at 2.10%, which is a positive and a very healthy position for a county.

Ms. Acker said, from an audit standpoint, Rock County's financial position is very favorable with no current concerns.

Ms. Acker and Ms. Jansen thanked Ms. Oja, and all the County staff for their cooperation.

<u>Committee Review and Approval of Per Meeting Allowances.</u> Supervisor Kraft moved approval of per meeting allowances in the amount of \$15,619.04, second by Supervisor Fox. ADOPTED.
