# FINANCE COMMITTEE March 18, 2010

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Mawhinney called the meeting of the Finance Committee to order at 7:30 A.M. on Thursday, March 18, 2010, in Conference Room N-1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Chair Mawhinney said there is a transfer for the Sheriff's Office. Supervisor Podzilni moved approval of the agenda with this addition, second by Supervisor Diestler. ADOPTED as amended.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Supervisor Diestler moved approval of the minutes of March 4, 2010 as presented, second by Supervisor Podzilni. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications, Announcements, Information.</u> Mr. Crittenden said they finished the document imaging training at the Sheriff's Office, they are putting in computers at the Juvenile Detention Center and working with the School Districts so the juveniles will be able to do their homework.

Ms. Brown said the bill the County Treasurers passed requires the sharing of omitted taxes and restricts charge backs of delinquent personal property taxes. With this new tax law, all tax paying jurisdictions will share equally in the gains and losses.

Ms. Brown informed the Committee that they officially begin the foreclosure process on March 1<sup>st</sup>. This is when they contract with a local title company to do tax searches on potential foreclosure parcels. Last year they started with 85 parcels having unpaid 2005 property taxes and ended up foreclosing on 18. This year they are starting with 170 parcels having unpaid 2006 property taxes.
