Intake Process

The intake process involves an initial contact, a comprehensive assessment, and completing a referral. Services can be provided at our offices, your home, or in the community.

- The initial contact is approximately a 20-minute phone call or meeting during which we listen and ask some questions to identify each person's needs.
- 2. When a comprehensive
 assessment for Rock County
 services is indicated, we will
 schedule a 2-3 hour in-person
 assessment which includes a
 more in-depth discussion.
- We will then discuss referral options with the client and help to make the connection to the appropriate services.


