COUNTY BOARD STAFF COMMITTEE Minutes – April 23, 2013

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Podzilni called the meeting of the County Board Staff Committee to order at 4:00 P.M. in Conference Room N-1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>: Supervisors Podzilni, Kraft, Arnold, Brill, Bussie, Jensen, Mawhinney, Peer and Yankee.

Committee Members Absent: None.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Supervisor Arnold moved approval of the amended agenda, second by Supervisor Yankee. ADOPTED.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. Supervisor Peer moved approval of the minutes of April 9, 2013 as presented, second by Supervisor Mawhinney. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>. Mr. Arrowood handed out and went over an incident where, if not for the person in the control tower, a jet and a Cessna may have collided. Mr. Burdick handed out lists of representatives in the House and Senate and he and Mr. Arrowood encouraged everyone to contact them asking for support/co-sponsor the bill to keep the control tower open.

Supervisor Brill said he had a call from a constituent suggesting the County, the City of Janesville and City of Beloit all share the cost of \$500,000 to keep the control tower open.

Mr. Arrowood said that is one proposal that he has heard and some of the other comments are: 1) make the controllers County employees; 2) liability insurance would be the largest cost; 3) he offered to come up with schedules to lessen the cost; and 4) he said he has had as many as 30 aircraft on the radar at one time.

The Committee suggested handing out copies of the House and Senate lists to the County Board.

Mr. Knutson said the County has joined the lawsuit.

Mr. Knutson said he received a letter back from Congressman Ryan, which said he had contacted the FAA on the closures.

Supervisor Bussie reminded everyone of the Rock Haven tour for the County Board on April 30 at 4 P.M.
