### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Healthy births and healthy infants are an important focus of the Rock County Health Department's services. The public health nurses at the Rock County Health Department provide pregnant women and new mothers in Rock County with education, resources, and referrals to other services to help pregnant women have healthy births and to promote normal growth and development of the infants after birth.

Infant/fetal birth and death records give the health department staff insight into risk factors that may contribute to infant morbidity and mortality. Being aware of the risk factors helps the public health nurses provide education and referral for appropriate resources to decrease the risk for infant deaths.

This \$2,000 grant from the Stateline Community Foundation will enable the Rock County Health Department to purchase needed infant/fetal birth and death records from the State of Wisconsin, which will provide essential information to the health department concerning risk factors and causes of infant mortality.

### Accepting Public Health Infrastructure Grant and Amending the 2011 Rock County Health Department Budget

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rock County Health Department is seeking national accreditation through the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB). In order to obtain assistance for the costs of staff time associated with the accreditation process, the health department applied for and was awarded a \$3,000 Public Health Infrastructure Grant from the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services. These funds are federal pass-through dollars from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

The funds received from this grant will provide Rock County Health Department with the means to complete the first steps toward accreditation, which are the self-assessment tool and quality improvement project. These tools will help Rock County Health Department obtain measurable feedback on the strengths of the department and performance management processes, as well as opportunities for continuous quality improvement.

The end result of the accreditation process will assist Rock County Health Department to improve the quality and performance of its programs and services in order to make the greatest impact within the Rock County community.

### How Healthy Is Your Home?

How healthy is your home? It may seem a bit bizarre to think about your home as healthy or unhealthy. It may not be something you've even thought of before. But having a healthy home is just as important to your overall wellness as keeping your mind sharp and your body strong. Unsafe housing increases the risk for injury and illness and continues to affect the health of millions of people of all income levels and geographic areas. In fact, one third of all injuries occur in the home!

The CDC offers easy tips and solutions to make your home or living area healthier. If you are interested, you can find more information on the CDC's Healthy Homes website.

### **Drinking Water Safety**

- The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulates drinking (tap) water from large public water systems across the country. However, one in seven Americans relies on private wells and small public water systems, which the EPA does not regulate. If your drinking water comes from a well, test it for contaminants annually.
- If you have a septic system, properly maintain it to prevent illness.

### **Indoor Air Quality**

- Adopt a smoke-free home.
- Install a battery-operated carbon monoxide detector near bedrooms and check or replace the battery when you change your clocks each spring and fall.
- Test your home for radon gas.
- Never run cars, lawnmowers, and other combustion devices inside the garage.
- Properly ventilate rooms with high humidity, such as bathrooms and kitchens to avoid moisture build-up and mold.

### **Injury Prevention**

- To prevent falls install grab bars in showers and tubs, use nonslip mats in bathtubs and showers, install stair rails, have good lighting, keep stairs in good repair, keep stairs free of clutter, and use safety gates in homes with young children.
- To prevent fire-related injuries keep flammable objects away from the stove, install smoke alarms on every floor, make sure every bedroom has two exits in case of a fire, and practice your fire escape plan.

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• To prevent drowning supervise young children in bathtubs, always watch young children while they are swimming or playing around water, and teach your children how to swim.

### **Poisoning Prevention**

- Make sure your child does not have access to peeling paint or chewable surfaces painted with lead-based paint.
- Use and store chemicals, household cleaning products, and pesticides according to label instructions and out of reach of children.
- Take all medicines as directed and store out of the reach of children. Dispose of the medication properly when you are finished (i.e. drop box, Rx Roundup event, etc.)

### **Food Safety**

- Wash your hands with soap and water before preparing food.
- Wash produce and cutting boards often.
- Use a food thermometer to cook meat and poultry to proper temperatures.
- Refrigerate food within 2 hours of serving.

Make a healthier home your priority this year and think about implementing some of these tips. Taking these small steps now toward a safer and healthier home will protect you and your loved ones from injury and illness in the future.
