- 2. Arrive at 9:50 am. Fox Den Storage Unit Project, Section 15, Janesville Township. Observe construction project regulated through the Erosion Control and Storm Water Management Ordinances. Depart at 10:05 am.
- **3.** Arrive at 10:10 am. McClary Farms LLC, Section 16, Janesville Township. Observe new manure storage facility and associated practices. Discuss challenges of the property. **Depart at 10:40 am.**
- **4.** Arrive at 10:50 am. Krumwiede Property, Section 34, Center Township. View stream bank stabilization project and buffer strip installation completed in 2012. **Depart at 11:10** am.
