In this role, she helped people pay back their victims by assisting them to find employment. Ms. Hartung also worked with youth in finding them volunteer opportunities by searching out local agencies willing to allow kids to complete their community service hours. In addition, Ms. Hartung worked with the Children's Community Support Network as a Service Coordinator, Ms. Hartung promoted the mission of keeping kids in the home, out of jail, and in school by working with families to create service plans which focused on attaining their family goals. In January 2009, Ms. Hartung transferred to the Long Term Support Division to support frail elderly and physically disabled adults in the community who were on the COP and Waiver programs. Ms. Hartung coordinated services such as: supportive homecare, meals, lawn/snow removal, medical supplies, and a variety of other needed services. Ms. Hartung was also the Lead Case Manager for the Alzheimer's Family Caregiver Support Program (AFCSP.) As the lead AFCSP worker, Ms. Hartung worked with individuals and their family members who have been afflicted with a dementia diagnosis. She provided resources to these families and authorized payments to support victims of dementia and their caregivers. Ms. Hartung advocated and worked on behalf of her clients; always searching for services and offering a helping hand. Ms. Hartung will be retiring from Rock County Department of Human Services on August 3, 2012; and,
