Minutes of the Rock County Public Works Committee September 10, 2019

The Friends Group will be reviewing the accomplishments and condition of Rock County parks. They will have a State of Rock County Parks Presentation from Ms. Friend.

The Rock Trail Coalition announced a thirteen mile round trip bicycle Gravel Ride Thursday, September 12, 2019 from Big Hill Park, Beloit, WI to Tripp Road, Afton, WI to promote the Peace Trail.

Mr. Finney, of Rock County Multi-Use Trail Group, announced a Work Day will take place at Gibbs Lake September 16, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

## PARKS BUSINESS

<u>Discussion and Presentation – Vandewalle and Associates, Inc. (POROS Plan Consultants). (See attached.)</u> Mr. Rohr and Mr. Slavney presented information for the POROS Plan for Rock County Parks and reviewed the timeline included in the distributed packet. Committee members asked questions and progression will be discussed at future Parks meetings.

<u>Resolution – Acceptance of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Rock County 2019-2020</u> <u>Snowmobile Trail Maintenance Grant S-5382.</u> Supervisors Richard and Zajac moved the Resolution. Mr. Traynor stated the grant is completed every year and the rate per mile did not change (for 2020). The miles changed from 226.4 to 214.6. MOTION CARRIED.

<u>Discussion and Possible Action – Town of Rock Baseball Park.</u> Mr. Traynor reported meeting with the Town of Rock to discuss the status of the Town of Rock donating Baseball Park to Rock County. Rock County prefers to own Baseball Park if Town of Rock agrees. Guest and Velo Club (bicycle) member, Mr. Schlegel, reported the prospects that exist in connecting the only bike trail now at Rockport Park to the additional Baseball Park and the opportunities this creates for Rock County. The Velo Club volunteers maintain the Rockport Park Trail and could do the same for the Baseball Park Trail. Baseball Park could also potentially bring in revenue from large corporations/venues renting the park.

Further discussion will take place at future meetings with the Town of Rock and no decision has been finalized at this juncture. Committee members voiced their concerns and Mr. Traynor will report new information to the Committee when it is obtained.

Parks Manager Report. Mr. Traynor provided information on the items listed in his report.

Maintenance Update – Mowing is caught up.

Tree and Trail Work – More time now exists to maintain and update these tasks.

Task Tuesdays – Parks crew will review and spend one day a week focusing on specific park concerns/tasks other than mowing.

POROS Plan Update - Status is ongoing; survey will be distributed week of September 16, 2019 and anyone who would like to contribute contacts may forward them to Ms. Friend or Mr. Traynor.

Beckman Mill - Heritage Days was September 8, 2019. Ms. Friend attended the gathering and stated there were many in attendance/was a great turnout.

Beckman Mill Playground Update – Approval was obtained at the last Parks Committee Meeting August 13, 2019. The proposed installation date is September 27, 2019. Mr. Traynor has reviewed the same with Lee Recreation and the Parks crew will be starting site prep within the next week.

Tree Identification Program Progress at Carver Roehl – Mr. Hessenauer and Ms. Friend will attend Fall Harvest Days (October 6, 2019) at the park. The new identifying tree signs are completed and ready to install. Mr. Traynor presented a sample of the tree signs. The signs have a ten year warranty and will be placed on a 4x4 post near the tree in which they reference.

Murwin Park, Progress Update on Emergency Signs – Mr. Traynor was informed by PaddleTime that signage along the Yahara River has not been put in place as of yet.

Royce Dallman Celebration of Life incident from August 26, 2019 - Repair estimate for the damaged asphalt is approximately \$3,000. Repairs are intended to be done by Fall 2019. Citations were issued from the occurrence.

Peace Trail - Work Day event is August 27 and September 9, 2019. Appreciation goes to the Rock Trail Coalition!

Park 2020 Budget, Information on Park Hours – Mr. Traynor distributed a statistics handout outlining the Parks crew and workload from 1955 to current. Mr. Traynor requests the addition of one new permanent employee in the 2020 budget due to the increase of duties/tasks required of the Parks Department. The Friends Groups and volunteers have and continue to assist with events and minor maintenance of Rock County Parks.

<u>Community Coordinator Report.</u> Committee members reviewed the report. Chair Bussie and Supervisor Richard compliment Ms. Friend on her efforts and accomplishments as Community Coordinator.

#### - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY –

#### AUTHORIZING APPLICATION WITH WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR COUNTY CONSERVATION AIDS GRANT FUNDS

Each Wisconsin County is allocated a certain amount of money annually to fund small projects on a 50/50 match basis. Rock County may apply for a maximum of \$1,927 in 2019 for use from October 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021. Additional funds may be available after initial funds are distributed. Grant funds unclaimed by a county by the October 1<sup>st</sup> deadline will first be reallocated to other counties in the same DNR region that have requested additional project funds. Though this funding source requires a 50% match by the County, all time and materials supplied by the Parks and Highway Divisions, as well as other community resources may be used as in-kind match.

Rock County Parks plans to use this funding source to help pay for a (kayak/canoe) boat launch at Murwin Park. Kayaking has become a popular activity in Rock County. A boat launch at Murwin Park was recommended in the 2015-2020 Rock County, Wisconsin Parks, Outdoor Recreation and Open Space (POROS) Plan. Murwin Park is located approximately 11 miles northwest from the City of Janesville. This 40+ acre park encloses a substantial amount of shoreline of the Yahara River at the Village of Fulton. A boat launch would improve river access due to an increase in recreational activities. Murwin Park would provide an excellent place to launch to travel downstream to the confluence with the Rock River or a takeout point for people paddling the Yahara River.
