<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Brill called the meeting of the General Services Committee to order at 8:00 A.M., Tuesday, July 3, 2018 in the Conference Room at the Health Department.

Awarding Contract for Carpet Replacement at Vacant Adolescent Service Center (ASC) Building

Awarding the Contract for the Installation of an In-Building Distributed Antenna System at UW Rock County Campus
"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock County Board Supervisors duly assembled this day of 2018 does hereby approve an authorize awarding a contract in the amount of \$157,980 to Telamon out of Elk Grov Village, IL.
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a \$15,000 contingency also be approved to covany possible unforeseen items."
Supervisor Zajac moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Rashkin
Mr. Sutherland explained this is part of the mass security system.

<u>Updates.</u>
Discussion and Possible Approval to Relocate the UW Extension Department

Mr. Sutherland explained, anytime a department is relocated, the governing committee and the General Services Committee both need to act on the approval of the relocation. Mr. Sutherland went over the square footage and setup between the old and new locations for the UW Extension offices; the impact to the community would be almost nonexistent; and it looks like the move would be a better fit for the department.

Supervisor Rashkin moved approval to relocate the UW Extension Department to the vacant Adolescent Service Center building contingent on Agriculture and Extension Committee approval, second by Supervisor Potter. ADOPTED.

<u>Discussion of Change Order for Health Care Center Security Access</u> Mr. Sutherland handed out copies of the change order and said it is for the purchase and installation of two electric retraction conversion kits to allow for the release of the egress doors in an emergency.

Review of Semi-Annual Report at Conferences / Conventions Mr. Sutherland explained there were a number of trainings his staff have attended, but none have gone over the \$1,000 per event, per employee.

The Committee accepted the report.

<u>Update and Discussion on old Rock Haven Building Demo Schedule</u> Mr. Sutherland went over the schedule, said security fence surrounds the old building, and the tunnel will have a wall put up to block it before the tunnel is removed. Mr. Sutherland said the flagpole and some of the bricks from the old building were removed and will be moved to the new building.
