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# February "Healthful Hint" Monthly Health News Column "Is it Always Good to be Green?"

For a lot of people, being green means keeping things "all natural" – eating organic food, buying clothes made of natural fibers and using natural building materials in their homes. Many people would argue that following a more natural lifestyle can be good for your health. However, there are some things that are "all natural" that are not healthy at all. One of these is radon gas.

Radon is a naturally occurring radioactive gas that seeps out of the soil. It is found in low levels outdoors, but inside your home it can build-up and become dangerous. Long-term exposure to high levels of radon can increase a person's risk of getting lung cancer. The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) estimates that it causes 20,000 lung cancer deaths per year in the United States. Radon is the leading cause of lung cancer in people who have never smoked.

Radon gets into buildings through cracks, gaps, holes, crawlspaces, and pipe penetrations that are in contact with the ground. Radon can also come in through well water, but luckily this is not a common source in Rock County. Radon is colorless and odorless. In fact, it is impossible to know it is there without doing a test.

Fortunately, testing for radon is easy. It can be done by homeowners and takes only two days. A two day short-term test is the most common way to test. The test consists of a charcoal canister that is placed in the lowest lived-in level of your home, away from any drafts, and not in a kitchen or bathroom. If your basement is "finished" or you have a workshop or exercise area that gets used frequently, then you would want to test in your basement. If not, test on the first floor. Radon is usually at its highest levels in basements, but it can become a problem on upper floors as well.

Make sure to keep your windows closed for the duration of the test. After the test canister has been out for two days, it is placed into a special envelope and mailed to the lab for analysis. Here's a tip: When buying a test kit, make sure lab testing is included in the purchase price. That way you won't be surprised by lab fees. Within a week or two of mailing, you should receive your test result.

If testing indicates that you have high radon in your home, don't panic. There are systems available that can easily reduce your radon to safe levels. These systems can usually be installed in less than a day and are comparable in cost to other home repairs. You should always hire a certified radon mitigation system installer and make sure to check references.

It is important to remember that radon levels can be significantly different from house to house. Don't let your neighbors low test result keep you from performing a test. The EPA recommends that every household be tested, even in areas that tend to have lower levels.

They also have information on radon's health effects and maps showing where radon is most prevalent.
