<u>Update on Courthouse Security - Phase 2 and 3</u> Mr. Sutherland said, due to the weather, the project is about one week behind schedule, but the contractor feels they should be back on track shortly. The noise level has been able to be kept at a minimum. One neighbor has complained about the noise but seems to be okay as long as we keep her updated on what will be done and the time. He said over the next couple weeks they will be working on the millwork. The Department Heads have given a schedule of when the best times, and worst times, for the work to be done. Mr. Sutherland said some of the electrical work will be done on Saturday and the sprinklers are being worked on that day.
