Rock Haven already has a contract with Agrace Hospice (formerly HospiceCare, Inc.). Chair Bussie moved approval of the contract. Supervisor Beaver seconded the motion. ADOPTED.

<u>WAHSA Name Change to "LeadingAge" (Wisconsin)</u> - Ms. Gunderson said the new name is appropriate as WAHSA continues to be and always has been a leader in advocating for services for the aging.
