TO RECOGNIZE ROCK COUNTY SOCIAL WORKERS

WHEREAS, March has been declared National Social Worker Recognition Month; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors, representing the citizens of Rock County, wish to recognize the Rock County Human Services Social Workers for their excellence in delivering services to the citizens of Rock County; and,

WHEREAS, the Social Workers of the Rock County Department of Human Services provide services to a wide variety of Rock County citizens; and,

WHEREAS, Social Workers in the Mental Health area provide crisis counseling and treatment services to reduce the need for hospital based care; and services to maintain clients in the community; and provide family crisis services, in-home family services as well as services to children with severe and persistent mental illness to provide support to the families and reduce the need for out of home placement of children and adolescents by providing services to Rock County residents who otherwise might be a danger to self or others, and further by addressing emotional/behavioral patterns that otherwise adversely impact on the family and community; and,

WHEREAS, the Social Workers in the Juvenile Justice Services Division perform important and difficult work, serving children/youth referred for delinquent behavior and/or for being beyond parental control; and,

WHEREAS, the Child Protective Services Social Workers provide essential safety services and respond to reports of abuse and neglect and work to control for the safety of children who are at risk of abuse, maltreatment and/or neglect, and intervene to alter the conditions within the families which create the risk of maltreatment and/or neglect, relying upon home-based services and collaboration with other professionals providing essential services to these children/families; and.

WHEREAS, the Social Workers in the Adult Community Services area provide services to individuals with persistent and chronic mental illness assisting them to live in the community; and prevent costly hospitalizations whenever possible; and,

WHEREAS, the Social Workers in the Long Term Support Division perform essential work to ensure needed services are provided for the frail elderly and physically disabled living in the community; by investigating reports of elder/adult abuse and neglect, providing for their health and safety, and meeting unmet needs by linking them to community resources; all of which allows these individuals to remain independently in the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors, duly assembled this _______day of _______, 2011, do hereby recognize the Rock County Social Workers for their excellent work and diligent efforts in the delivery of services to needy Rock County citizens and their families in 2011.

Opposing the Initiative in the Governor's Budget that removes Income Maintenance Administration from the Counties and Creates a State Operated Centralized Income Maintenance Unit

1 WHEREAS, the State 2011-2013 Biennial Budget Bill requires that the income maintenance administration unit (IM unit) services be centralized at the State by May 1, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, the income maintenance function is the biggest component of the Economic Support Division that is presently located in the Rock County Job Center; and,

WHEREAS, approximately 50 Economic Support workers enroll eligible Rock County residents in economic assistance benefits such as food share and Medicaid and presently maintain an unduplicated caseload of 15,800 people; and,

WHEREAS, those County positions would be eliminated and a centralized income maintenance would be created and operated by a private entity under contract with the State; and,

WHEREAS, while the consolidation of the IM functions would save Rock County approximately \$140,000 on an annual basis, it would also result in a number of adverse unintended consequences that would cost money and diminish services; and,

WHEREAS, the Economic Support Division occupies a large portion of the Job Center, and if it is eliminated, the rent will increase significantly for the other County operations and partner agencies colocated in the Job Center; and,

WHEREAS, the Job Center lease expires on December 31, 2011 and it is anticipated that the lease will be extended on a month to month basis until the full impact of the IM consolidation is understood and the Job Center partners can agree to a higher rent and a long term commitment; and,

WHEREAS, the State presently operates Badger Care Core, Badger Care Core Plus, and FoodShare through an Enrollment Services Center (ESC) operated by a private entity, which is the identical model to what is being proposed for the State centralized IM functions; and,

WHEREAS, at present, only 16% of its Badger Care Core, Badger Care Core Plus, and FoodShare cases are being processed within the stated goal of less than the self-imposed thirty-day enrollment standard; and,

WHEREAS, operating an effective income maintenance function requires knowledgeable and committed staff in a local setting that can enroll clients in a timely fashion without errors, and solve complex problems in a short period of time so that County residents do not go without basic needs; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Board views IM as a core mission of the Department and not having a local presence of IM staff would result in less effective service delivery and more costly Child Protective Services, Mental Health and Community Support programs, Juvenile Justice Services, and Long Term Support programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this _____ day of _____, 2011, does hereby oppose the initiative in the Governor's Budget that takes income maintenance administration away from the counties and creates a statewide centralized Income Maintenance Unit; and,
