ISSUE - APPROVE DESIGN ENGINEERING FOR STREET LIGHTING- CTH G

<u>DISCUSSION</u> - Near the south end of the CTH G Mega Project, sidewalks and bicycle lanes are being planned. To assure safe use of these facilities, it is advisable to provide street lighting.

The eastern side of the route between Huebbe Parkway and Philhower Road is within the City of Beloit. The City has expressed an interest in having this portion of the project lit by new street lights that are both functional and aesthetic. The County will negotiate a cost sharing agreement with the City for both the design and construction of the street lighting. This route will continue as another significant entrance to the community, serving not only the City but the nearby Towns.

Installing street lights as part of the road reconstruction project is possible under the funding rules. This is desirable, as it avoids additional disruption and restoration if done separately from the road construction.

This proposal is to add design of the street lighting to the roadway design contract of AECOM, Inc. These documents would be incorporated into the roadway plans and be bid and constructed in conjunction with the roadway in 2015. There would be an economy of scale in both the design effort and for construction. The additional lighting design fee proposal is for \$34,525. It is proposed to reallocate funds already approved for the Mega Project for design. Since final roadway plans are not complete, we are still unsure of the construction cost estimates. A reduction in current construction cost estimates is likely and would fund this new task.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u> - Approval of the design contract change.
