2. GOVERNANCE COMMITTEE –

- Chair Remarks

- Executive Directors Report

5. BOARD EDUCATION

- Staff Director covered the history, accomplishments and future direction of Housing Development. It was asked that an ad hoc committee be formed to address the following questions:
 - o What level of involvement should CAI have in Beloit's Merrill Neighborhood after the initial project is done?
 - O How should CAI utilize its ongoing HOME allocations in Rock County? Should it consider undertaking a housing redevelopment project in Janesville?
 - o What should CAI's role being in Walworth County?
 - o Launch a multi-family to support its mission and to potentially raise funds to support the broader housing agenda?
 - o Establish a HOME-funded rehab loan or downpayment assistance program?
 - o What has the potential to impact families that we serve?
 - o How can we help empower residents to take on challenges in their neighborhoods?

• Beloit's housing complex will be coming to the end of its contract. We are looking into the legal ramifications of going from partner to owner and the best way to unravel the partnership.

ACTION: Linda Seemeyer motioned for staff to form an ad hoc committee to address the direction of Housing Development, Jennifer Griffith seconded, accepted unanimously.
