ROCK COUNTY PARK AND CONSERVATION DIVISION REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGE PERMIT

- I. These permits shall only be issued to civic groups for specific events.
- II. Only licensed bartenders shall be used.
- III. All Wisconsin Statutes in relation to the dispensing and consumption of fermented malt beverages shall be strictly enforced.
- IV. A. A uniformed law enforcement officer will be at the specified sales area to conduct any checking of identification to determine age as may be necessary, and will be continually present during operation of the beer sales area.
 - B. Permittee shall provide for checking and enforcement personnel to insure all these requirements are met.
- V. The Permit shall be valid for a single specified event and can be revoked with no notice if rules and requirements are not met.
- VI. No "carry-in alcoholic beverages" are permitted, only fermented malt beverages sold on site may be possessed or consumed on site.
- VII. Permittee shall furnish a "Certificate of Insurance" naming Rock County as an additional insured. This certificate must be in Rock County's possession prior to the grounds being set up for the event.

An excerpt from Chapter 11 of the Rock County Ordinances, 11.01(18) Intoxicants Prohibited:

"No person shall consume or possess any fermented malt beverage or intoxicating liquor, as defined by 1987 Wisconsin Statutes, sec. 125.02, on any property owned by Rock County, except that portion of the county airport designated by the Public Works Committee. Such possession and consumption of fermented malt beverages on the airport premises shall be subject to all applicable State Statutes and local ordinances including licensing of the restaurant operation by the appropriate municipal authority. The consumption of fermented malt beverages and wine, in all parks, except the 4-H County Fair Grounds, is allowed under a temporary permit issued by the Public Works Committee. The consumption of fermented malt beverages and wine on the 4-H County Fair Grounds is allowed under a temporary permit issued by the Agriculture and Extension Education Committee. Such temporary permits shall be subject to local licensing requirements and such other restrictions as the respective Committees may deems to be in the public interest. The Public Works and Agriculture and Extension Education committees may establish fees for the issuance of the permits referred to in sub (a) above to help defray the costs of park clean up.

PERMIT

Town of Turtle Fire Department is hereby authorized to dispense fermented malt beverages at
Sweet-Allyn County Park from June 5, 2010 through June 6, 2010
subject to licensing and state and local laws. This Permit is issued by the Rock County Public
Works Committee under authority granted in Chapter 11/01, Subchapter 18, of the Rock County
Ordinances.

- Executive Summary -Awarding Contracts for Boardwalk and Trail System Project at Beckman Mill County Park

Rock County is the owner of the Beckman Mill County Park and has been awarded matching grant money for several projects there through the Acquisition and Development of Local Parks Program (ADLP) and Urban Rivers Grant Program (URGP) by the DNR. This project includes the boardwalk and trail system throughout the campus. The bid was divided into three contracts.

The lowest responsible total bid for both contract #1 in the amount of \$45,010 for the boardwalk and foot bridge and contract #2 in the amount of \$18,450 for the aggregate trail was Janke Construction of Athens, Wisconsin for a combined total of \$63,460.

There was a tie for contract #2. As stated in the bid documents if two or more bidders submit identical bids, Rock County will make award to bidder of its choice and such decision will be final. Staff recommends to award both contracts #1 and #2 to Janke Construction because the total of both contracts was less and it will be more efficient use of staff time in dealing with only one contractor on both contracts.

The lowest responsible bid for contract #3 for the north woods trail section was Grade Tech Pavers Inc., of Ixonia, Wisconsin for \$6,475.

Funds for this project are included in the 2010 budget.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY -

ACCEPTANCE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES COUNTY FISH AND GAME PROJECT GRANT FUNDS

Each Wisconsin County is allocated a certain amount of money annually to fund small projects on a 50/50 match basis. Rock County applied for the maximum of \$1,946 in 2010. Parks planned to access this funding source to help pay for invasive species control at Carver-Roehl Park. Though this funding source requires a 50% match by the County, all time and materials supplied by the Parks and Highway Divisions, as well as other community resources, may be used as in-kind match. Our match is planned to be in kind labor with minimal staff involvement. The Friends of Carver-Roehl and local volunteers have expressed strong interest in continued assistance with this project.

After applying and being awarded the grant the amount was increased to \$2,035. The initial species to be controlled using this grant is garlic mustard, with buckthorn being a second priority. That area has been addressed by this grant the last 3 years and volunteer efforts over the past ten years.

Staff has solicited three quotes on the work and one was accepted within the funding parameters.

- EXECUTIVE SUMMARY -

AUTHORIZING APPLICATION WITH WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR WARREN KNOWLES-GAYLORD NELSON STEWARDSHIP GRANT FUNDS

The Rock County Parks, Outdoor Recreation, and Open Space (POROS) Plan implementation schedule identifies land acquisition near the Tiffany five arch stone bridge as a project in process. In order to move forward on this project, the Parks Division desires to make application for Department of Natural Resources Stewardship Funds. If the application is successful, the grant funds would be used to purchase property to enhance the viewing of the Tiffany Bridge.

The grant being applied for requires a 50/50 match of local funds. The anticipated project is \$184,000 of which, approximately \$92,000 would be Stewardship Funds. The \$92,000 local match would include \$50,000 in the current budget for the purpose of land acquisition, and the balance of \$42,000 would be appropriated from the Park's portion of the ATC Funds. Should the application be successful, further action from the Board would be required to authorize land purchase and appropriate funding.
