APPROVE RELOCATION ORDER FOR CTH J (TURTLE CREEK BRIDGE B-53-0011) RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The bridge design for the reconstruction of the CTH J Bridge over the Turtle Creek (B-53-0011) is complete. To carry out the project, the County must acquire certain interests in order for the reconstruction of the bridge to occur and otherwise complete the project. It is required by Statute that the County Board pass a Relocation Order as the first legal step in the process.

This resolution adopts the Revised Relocation Order and delegates responsibility for implementation to the Public Works Committee and Director of Public Works.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

APPROVING PLAT OF SURVEY TO TRANSFER EXISTING ROW ON CTH M

The Rock County Department of Public Works received a request from two adjacent property owners along the CTH M corridor to consider transferring excessive right-of-way to the adjacent property owners as provided in the attached plat of survey.

In 1969, plans were approved for the reconstruction of CTH M. The plans included a realignment of a curve, approximately 1,350 feet in length, located between approximately 2,800 and 4,150 feet east of USH 51.

With the realignment of the curve, the County purchased extra right-of-way on the north side of CTH M and maintained ownership and jurisdiction of the previous right-of-way resulting in right-of-way widths varying from 110 feet to approximately 210 feet. Typical highway rights-of-way are between 66 feet and 100 feet in width.

Highway right-of-way is a defined strip of land devoted primarily to transportation purposes, including pavement, shoulders, drainage systems and clear zones. Utilities will also utilize the right-of-way for housing their infrastructure with the approval of jurisdictional authority.

In reviewing this area, it was determined that maintaining the proposed right-of-way provided in the attached plat of survey would allow maintenance of the existing drainage system without regrading, blend well with existing right-of-way on either side of the curve, and allow for future expansion or widening if needed.

The excess right-of-way beyond the proposed right-of-way line, is not necessary for the safe operation and maintenance of this highway and is an added, unnecessary maintenance cost to the County.

Rock County Department of Public Works Division of Highways – Issue Paper Design Consultant Selection

ISSUE: Approve rankings of consulting engineers for the design of County Trunk Highway: CTH J (CTH O – Avalon Rd)

<u>DISCUSSION</u>: Public Works Staff solicited Statements of Qualifications (SOQ's) from eligible engineering consulting firms to provide roadway design for CTH J (CTH O – Avalon Rd). Sixteen consulting firms responded to the solicitation and three staff members reviewed and ranked the corresponding SOQ's.

Staff considered many criteria in putting together the rankings, including: project member experience, firm availability, previous similar project experience, and general approach to the respective project.

If approved by the Public Works Committee, staff will negotiate a contract with the top firm. Should the County and the top firm be unable to successfully negotiate a contract, the County will move on to the second ranked firm and etc. The rankings are shown below:

- 1. Baxter and Woodman, Inc.
- 2. R.H. Batterman and Co., Inc.
- 3. AECOM

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve ranking of firms and authorize negotiations of the contract as outlined above.
