#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The Finance Department has a 1.0 FTE Senior Buyer position vacated by a retiring incumbent and is requesting to delete this Senior Buyer position and create a 1.0 FTE Purchasing Specialist position. After reviewing the duties and responsibilities of the Purchasing Unit, it was determined that if we reorganize and shift responsibilities among staff, then a Purchasing Specialist position would meet our needs.

The Senior Buyer position is in Unilateral Pay Range 15 and the Purchasing Specialist position will be located in Unilateral Pay Range 8, therefore these changes will have a positive fiscal impact for the County.
