Recommendations for County Seal Approval Process

Periodically, outside groups will request to use the Rock County Seal. In an effort to apply consistent standards, the County Board Staff Committee asked that Administration research how other counties and nearby municipalities approve the use of their logo/seal. My findings are below.

After researching the approval process of Beloit and Janesville as well as Kenosha County and Waukesha County, it is noteworthy that all of the jurisdictions approve the use of their County Seal/City Logo administratively as long as certain conditions are met.

Consistent with these practices, the County Board Staff Committee could choose to authorize the use of the County Seal if all of the following conditions are met:

- The organization making the request is a non-profit
- The request is for one-time use
- Rock County and the organization serve the same client base
- Authorizing use of the Rock County Seal furthers the County's Mission

Alternatively, approval may also be granted under the follow circumstance:

• Rock County contracts for services with the organization or the organization does business on our behalf

By applying this framework, requests can be judged consistently using the same standards and may be approved or denied in a timely manner by the County Administrator's Office.

If there is a question about whether a request fits the conditions above, County staff could present the details to the County Board Staff Committee for their input and approval.

Executive Summary Facilities Superintendents Taking County Truck Home at Night

For the past 40 years the Facilities Superintendents have taken a County truck home at night. The county has a policy on this practice and the use of County owned trucks. This shows as a benefit on the Facilities Superintendents paychecks and they are taxed on this as a benefit. This taxable amount is set by the IRS.

When I started my position on June 6, 2016 I stopped this practice due to both Facilities Superintendents retiring and I could not see the value in this practice. I have since filled both positions and have evaluated this practice for 6 months. I do now feel there is value in them taking the trucks home at night. They are required to respond to the County buildings for all emergencies. They tour the buildings on their way in. They also provide additional assistance for snow removal of facilities parking lots in the winter.

I would like approval to reinstate this practice.
